REFLECTION QUESTIONS

How does knowing that God sees you in your struggles and joys change how you approach Him?

How does it feel to know that God knows everything about you and still loves you deeply?

How does God's constant presence give you comfort in your daily life?

What does it mean to you that God created you fearfully and wonderfully?

How does God's intimate knowledge of your life shape your trust in His plan for you?
